



## Mushin Racing Gears Up For Pleasure Valley

**Reynoldsburg, OH / June 29, 2010 /** With only four rounds remaining in the 2010 AMA-ATV Motocross Championship, Team Mushin Racing continues to surge forward as a team to be dealt with at each and every round of this year's series. Pro, Amateur and Youth team members turned heads at Round 7 at Muddy Creek MX in Blountville, Tennessee and the plan remains the same for the upcoming Round 8 in Armagh, Pennsylvania at Pleasure Valley.

Coming off his first top ten finish for the season, Mushin Racing's Cody Gibson has been given the green light to let it loose and churn some dirt now that he's completely heal from an early season accident which put him in a "protect my health" mode for the majority of the series. Fellow Pro class team member Thomas Brown continues to utilize consistent finishes in the class and, currently sitting in 6th place overall, Brown has his sights set on busting into the top five overall rankings as the 2010 AMA-ATV MX events wind down.

In the Amateur ranks, Chase Snapp and Jeffrey Rastrelli are a dominating pair in the Pro/Am classes. Snapp, leading the overall standings in the Pro/Am Production class, is dead set on adding to his points cushion of 23 points at the upcoming round in PA and cutting into the class leader's 7 point lead over him in the Pro/Am Unlimited class. Rastrelli, on the other hand, suffered a set back during Round 7 but is determined to knock the doors off the 3rd place overall position in both classes. Headed into the Pleasure Valley round, Rastrelli was only one point out of third overall in the Pro/Am Production class and a mere two points out of third in the Unlimited class.



### **Maci Devenport**

Team Mushin Racing's youth troops have turned heads all season long and the plan is to twist them off their necks as the season winds down. Maci Devenport, the team's female terror on the track, laid down a solid run at Round 7, putting herself in contention to take over the points lead in the 90 Auto Senior (12-15) class. Headed into Round 8 in South West Pennsylvania, Devenport needs only one point to put herself at the top of the pack in the class.

The Ward Brothers, Ashton and Kodi, two of the younger members of Mushin Racing's 2010 ATV Motocross Team, consistently create front runner havoc in more than one youth class. Kodi, the older of the two, snagged a second place overall finish in the 90 Auto Junior (8-11) class during Round 7, adding to his momentum after sitting out a number of rounds due to an injury. With four rounds to go he's broken into the top ten in the class and is definitely moving up in the rankings. Younger brother, Ashton, nabbed the holeshots at Muddy Creek in the 50 Limited Jr. (4-6) class and battled all weekend long in the summer heat, finishing third overall. Looking forward to the PA round, Ashton is prepped to take his Mushin Racing machine to the holeshot once again and chip away at the front runner's lead in the overall standings. Young Ward sat in second overall in the class with a seventeen point deficit to the leader as the Mushin Racing team geared up to head to Round 8 at Pleasure Valley.
